


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
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#### General Restrictions

No use shall be made of any land in any of the safety zones which creates or causes interfered with the operations of radio or electronic facilities on the airport or with radio or electronic communications between the airport and aircraft, makes it difficult for pilots to distinguish between airport lights and other lights, results in glare in the eyes of pilots using the airport, impairs visibility in the vicinity of the airport, or otherwise endangers the landing, taking off, or maneuvering of aircraft

#### Safety Zone "A"

Shall contain no buildings, temporary structures, exposed transmission lines, or other similar land use structural hazards, and shall be restroited to those uses which will not create, attract, or bring together an assembly of persons thereon. Permitted uses may include, but are not limited to, such uses as agriculture (seasonal crops), horticulture, raising of livestock, animal husbandry, wildlife habitat, light outdoor recreation (nonspectator), cemeteries, and auto parking without light standards or other above ground structures.

#### Safety Zone "B"

Sattery ZORE 'Es'.

Shall be restricted in use as follows. Each use shall be on a site whose area shall not be less than three acres. Each use shall not create, attract, or bring together a site population that would exceed 15 times that of the site acreage. Each site shall have no more than one building plot upon which any number of structures may be erected. A building plot shall be a single, uniform and non-contrived area, whose shape is unoporniticated and whose area shall not exceed the minimum ratios sated in the zoning ordinance. The following uses are specifically prohibited in zone E: churches, hospitals, schools, theaters, stadiums, hotels and motels, trailer courts, camp grounds, and other places of ruthlic or annimable assemble. public or semipublic assembly

#### Safety Zone "B-1"

Safety Zone "B-"
Shall be restricted in use as according to Safety Zone "B" and as follows. Each residential use shall be on a site whoe area shall not be less than 3 acres. For the purposes of this section, residential use is defined as a use exclusively for residential occupancy, including only one-family dwellings. Each residential use shall be further restricted as follows. Rush City Regional Airport users have the airspace right to go upon, over, and across the real estate in this Zone by means of any and all noise, at any level, which may now hereafter, directly or indirectly, arise from the flight of aircraft above the transition surface free of any claims by the landowner successors, heirs, personal representatives, or transition surface free of any claims by the landowner successors, heirs, personal representatives, or assigns, that noise from the flight of aircraft is unreasonable interference with the use and enjoyment of, or reduces the value of, the real easte in this Zone. A building plot shall be a single, uniform and non-contrived area, whose shape is uncomplicated and whose area shall not exceed the minimum raids stated in the Zoning Ordinance. Airport support uses are specifically excluded from the above requirements, and are subject to the requirements of Zone C. Such uses include fixed base operators, air charter operators, air cargo operations and improvements for support of these uses.

Safety Zone "C" is subject only to the general restrictions. Safety Zone "C" is enclosed within the perimeter of the horizontal zone.

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
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
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
